I refer you to the response given by Steve Dunn, Director General of NSW Fisheries, in a letter to you regarding various issues I raised regarding funding of projects. The third last paragraph states:

“In terms of the issues and concerns raised by the Anglers Action Group – there is always the opportunity to provide comment on the range of NSW Fisheries consultation papers, and to provide information or discuss issues with representatives on the expenditure committees or Advisory Council on Recreational Fishing”.

As we still have concerns regarding funding, and also for future reference as the need arises, how do members of the Anglers Action Group contact representatives of the various expenditure committees or ACoRF to either provide information or discuss issues?

Secondly, as contact with members of these committees was previously only been permitted through NSW Fisheries at Cronulla, does this reflect a relaxation or change of this policy by NSW Fisheries, or is this access only granted to members of the Anglers Action Group (Sydney Northside) Inc.
